### Other business

The Barony voted to purchase a 16x16 pavilion for \$1600 for events space including royals area, gold key, classroom, sensory space—right now we rely on borrowing personal tents and other baronies' tens for our events. It's currently being stored at Black Oak, which also raised the question of where Baronial goods should be stored long-term, as the trailer is full and many things are stored across officers' houses.

The Barony has discussed putting in bids for various Kingdom-level events, including bidding again for An Tir Twelfth Night and Bardic championship, or bidding for Kingdom Arts & Science & Rapier. Either would be at the Ashland Hills Hotel following a similar format to Principality A&S. Both ideas have gotten generally positive responses at Moot and multiple people expressed interest in helping organize if the bid was accepted.
